

Lesson 6: Resource Sheet 2

Weather-based definition

The state of the atmosphere at a particular place and time

The expected weather based on the average conditions experienced in a place over many years

How hot or cold it is

Any moisture reaching the ground

The amount of moisture in the air

The movement of air across the earth's surface

The droplets of water that form when moist air comes into contact with a cold surface

Frozen raindrops that fall during thunderstorms

Water vapour frozen into small ice crystals and falling in light white flakes

The process by which water turns from liquid into vapour

The process by which water vapour turns into a liquid

The measurement, in degrees, of a place's distance north or south of the equator

The four divisions of the year (spring, summer, autumn, and winter)

The direction in which something faces

Height above sea level (elevation)
